

ORDINANCE NO. 144

An Ordinance for the Purpose of Prohibiting  
Driving a Vehicle Where There is a Barrier  
or Warning Not to Cross in the City of Barling and  
to Prohibit a Barricade Except Under Certain  
Circumstances in the City of Barling, Arkansas

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Directors of the City of  
Barling, Arkansas, that:

SECTION 1: It shall be unlawful to drive any vehicle over  
any street, highway, or boulevard where there is a barrier or sign  
warning not to cross or instructing to detour and it shall be unlawful  
to so barricade a street, highway or boulevard without authority from  
the Chief of Police upon notice to the fire department.

SECTION 2: The penalty for the violation of this ordinance  
shall be a fine in the amount of Thirty-Five Dollars (\$35.00).

SECTION 3: The enactment of this ordinance would insure the  
protection of the health, safety and welfare of the public in the City  
of Barling, Arkansas, so that an emergency is hereby declared to exist  
and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after  
its passage.
