

ORDINANCE NO. 145

An Ordinance for the Purpose of Prohibiting  
the Backing of a Vehicle in Certain Circumstances  
in the City of Barling, Arkansas

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Directors of the City of  
Barling, Arkansas, that:

SECTION 1: The driver of any vehicle shall not back the  
vehicle into an intersection or over a crosswalk and shall not, in any  
event under any circumstance, back the vehicle unless such movement  
can be made without any risk of harm to persons or property.

SECTION 2: The penalty for the violation of this ordinance  
shall be a fine in the amount of Thirty-Five Dollars (\$35.00).

SECTION 3: The enactment of this ordinance would insure the  
protection of the health, safety and welfare of the public in the City  
of Barling, Arkansas, so that an emergency is hereby declared to exist  
and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after  
its passage.
