

An Ordinance Prohibiting Littering
Within the City of Barling, Arkansas,
Providing a Penalty Therefor and For Other Purposes

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Directors of the City of
Barling, Arkansas, that:

SECTION 1: The release or escape from any vehicle of any
form of litter, refuse, garbage or objects of any kind or nature,
liquid or solid, whether or not done negligently, knowingly or inten-
tionally on public property, streets or rights of way within the City
of Barling, Arkansas, is unlawful.

SECTION 2: The operator of said vehicle may be punished by a
fine not less than \$ 25.⁰⁰ nor more than
\$ 1000.⁰⁰. Each offense shall be considered a
separate violation of this Ordinance.

SECTION 3: If the operator of said vehicle is not known,
then it shall be presumed that the owner of said vehicle was the
operator.

SECTION 4: The enactment of this ordinance would insure the
protection of the health, safety and welfare of the public in the City
of Barling, Arkansas, so that an emergency is hereby declared to exist
and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after
its passage.
