

ORDINANCE NO. 159

An Ordinance to Prohibit Trespassing
Within the City of Barling, Arkansas

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Directors of the City of
Barling, Arkansas, that:

SECTION 1: It shall be unlawful for any person, without
either express or implied invitation, license or permission, in or
without a vehicle, to trespass upon the premises of another within the
City of Barling, and no person shall at any time trespass upon the
premises of another and peer or peep in any building situated on said
premises for the purpose of doing any unlawful act or mischief or
thing tending to disturb or annoy any occupant thereof, or calculated
to create a disturbance.

SECTION 2: Any person found guilty of violating this ordi-
nance shall be fined in an amount not less than \$50.00 nor more than
\$1,000.00.

SECTION 3: The enactment of this ordinance would ensure the
protection of the health, safety and welfare of the public in the City
of Barling, Arkansas, so that an emergency is hereby declared to exist
and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after
its passage.
