

ORDINANCE NO. 166

An Ordinance Prohibiting the Erection of Certain Structures Between Building Lines and Streets

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Directors of the City of Barling, Arkansas, that:

SECTION 1: It shall be unlawful to place, erect or construct any structure at any point between the building line of a residence and the street, which structure is designed for television or radio reception including but not limited to satellites, antennas, and structures associated therewith.

SECTION 2: Any person or entity found to be in violation of this Ordinance shall be subjected to a fine of not less than Twenty-Five Dollars (\$25.00) nor more than Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) for each day said violation occurs and each day shall be deemed to be a separate offense.

SECTION 3: There is hereby found and declared to be an immediate need for a prohibition against the structures as described herein in order to protect the property values and general appearance of the City of Barling. It is therefore declared that an emergency exists, and this Ordinance, being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public welfare shall be in full force and take effect immediately upon and after its passage.
