

ORDINANCE 239

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE DUMPING OF TRASH OR REFUSE WITHIN THE CITY OF BARLING ARKANSAS; PROVIDING A PENALTY THEREFOR, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE CITY OF BARLING, ARKANSAS AS FOLLOWS:

Section One: From and after the passage and approval of this ordinance it shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to dump or throw any form of refuse, cans, bottles, garbage, paper, yard waste, or other kinds or form of trash or garbage upon the streets, drainage ditches, or other utility and public easements of the City of Barling, Arkansas.

Section Two: Any person who is not paying for trash collection services by the City of Barling, shall be prohibited from dumping any form of refuse, cans, bottles, garbage, paper, yard waste, or other kinds or form of trash or garbage in the dumpsters provided for public use by the City of Barling for its residents.

Section Three: Any person, firm or firm or corporation who shall violate the provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction the penalty for the violation of this Ordinance shall be a fine in an amount not to exceed one hundred dollars (\$100.00), and each separate day in which said property remains in violation of this Ordinance shall constitute a separate offense.

Section Four: The City Administrator, or his/her agent, is hereby authorized to enforce the provisions of this ordinance.

Section Five: Passage of this Ordinance shall also include the repeal of Ordinance 74. Further, all other ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
