## **ORDINANCE 253**

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE LAND USE PLAN PREVIOUSLY ADOPTED BY THE PLANNING COMMISSION, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

BE IT NOW ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE CITY OF BARLING, ARKANSAS, THAT:

WHEREAS, the Planning Commission adopted a Land Use Plan on July 20, 1998, pursuant to Arkansas statutes after having conducted various studies and after having held a public hearing as required by law;

WHEREAS, the various studies concern the existing uses of land, the proposed uses to which land may be put in the future, and other matters relating to the use, preservation and development of land within the City of Barling including that land within the former military reservation known as Fort Chaffee;

BE IT THEREFORE ORDAINED by the City of Barling as follows:

SECTION 1: The Land Use Plan adopted by the Planning Commission has been reviewed by the Board of Directors and is hereby adopted.

SECTION 2: The Board of Directors requests that the Planning Commission consider, adopt, and transmit to it such ordinances as it may recommend to carry out or protect such Land Use Plan.

SECTION 3: The City Clerk is to place sufficient copies of the Land Use Plan on file for public inspection.
