

ORDINANCE NO. 292

AN ORDINANCE FOR THE PURPOSE OF PROVIDING FOR
THE SIGNING OF CHECKS, WARRANTS AND OTHER
DOCUMENTS IN THE ABSENCE OF THE CITY
ADMINISTRATOR.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE
CITY OF BARLING, AS FOLLOWS:

WHEREAS, it is necessary and appropriate that the City Administrator and the City Clerk are authorized to sign checks, warrants or other documents with both of said signatures being required on each of said documents;

WHEREAS, in the absence of the City Administrator of the City of Barling, it is necessary and considered appropriate that the Director of Public Works and the City Clerk be authorized to sign checks, warrants or other documents with both of said signature required on each of said documents.


NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained and enacted as follows:

SECTION 1: The Director of Public Works of the City of Barling, Arkansas, is hereby authorized to sign checks, warrants or other documents, along with the City Clerk during the absence of the City Administrator or the City Clerk. All signatures must be original signatures. No stamps or other automated signature(s) will be considered a valid signature for purposes of this ordinance.


SECTION 2: All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage.

SECTION 3: It is necessary in order to maintain the financial well being and to meet its obligations for the City of Barling to be able to issue checks in payment of its just obligations and to do other things as are required and it therefore being in the health, welfare and interest of the City of Barling, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effective from and after its passage.
